APPLICABLE LAWS

Directive 95/46/CE - "on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data".

Directive 2002/58/CE - "concerning the processing of personal data and the protection of privacy in the electronic communications sector".

Legislative Decree 30 June 2003, n. 196 - "Personal Data Protection Code" as amended or supplemented.

THE "DATA CONTROLLER"

As a consequence of the visit to this website, the data referring to identified or identifiable people are subject to be processed. The "Data Controller" of such processing is Intercos s.p.a., which is based in Via Marconi 84 20864 Agrate Brianza - MB, Italy.

PLACE OF THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The treatments related to the web services of this website take place at the service provider appropriately appointed as Data Processor and are only handled by technical staff in charge of occasional maintenance operations.

KINDS OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

- Navigation data -

In the course of their normal service, the computer-based systems and the software procedures involved in the working of this website come into possession of some personal information, the transmission of which is implied in the use of the protocols of Internet communication.

This information is not collected to be associated to any identified people, but, through processes and associations with data owned by third parties, they might by its own nature lead to the identification of users.

In this category of data are included the "IP addresses" or otherwise the names stored in the domain of the computers used by those who access the Site, the "addresses in notation URI (Uniform Resource Identifier)" of the required resources, the time of the request, the method used to forward the request to the server, the size of the file received in reply, the digit code showing the state of the reply given by the server (good, error, etc...) and other parameters connected with the operating system and the structure and conditions of the user's computer.

This data is used only to get anonymous statistical information about the use of the Site and to check its correct performance and is deleted immediately after processing. The data might be used to investigate responsibilities, should there be any data processing offences against the Site: apart from this possibility, at present the data on Web contacts does not last for more than seven days.

- Data voluntary provided by the user -

The optional, explicit and voluntary forwarding of personal data from the user on registration forms present on this website implies the subsequent acquisition of such data provided by the sender, which is essential to the procession of the required service. Specific, concise information to data subjects will progressively be reported or displayed on the pages of the website set up for particular services on demand.

COOKIES

Cookies are text files placed on your computer's hard drive by a web page server. Your computer is probably configured to accept cookies, but you can modify your parameters to reject them. We recommend you do this if you are concerned about receiving cookies.

Cookie may be either "first party cookie" or "third-party cookie".

1. "first party cookie" will be used to refer to a cookie set by the data controller. For this kind of cookies the information notice is due from the data controller which has to inform the user about the way to block the cookie.
2. "third party cookies" are cookies that are set by websites that belong to a domain that is other than the domain of the website visited by the user: For this kind of cookies the information notice and the information concerning the way to block the cookie are due from the third part. The data controller has to indicate the link to the third party website where the user can find the mentioned information.

COOKIE USED IN THIS WEBSITE

The website www.intercos.com uses the so-called session cookies (for example the cookie PHPSESSID, which concerns the working session), i.e. those cookies that are not stored in a persistent manner on the user's computer and disappear when his browser is closed. Their use is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) which are necessary to allow the use of a given service and the secure and efficient exploration of the Website. The so-called session cookies used in this Website do not use other computer techniques that may prejudice the confidentiality of the users' navigation and do not allow for the acquisition of the users' personal data.

In addition, the website www.intercos.com uses Google Analytics' service.

In particular, cookies from _utma to _umtz are used by Google Analytics to control how many people look at the website.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

VOLUNTARY PROVIDING OF PERSONAL DATA

PROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS

Personal data is processed with automated instruments only for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed.

Specific security procedures are kept to prevent the risk of their destruction or loss, whether by accident or not, of unauthorized access to the data or of processing operations that are either unlawful or inconsistent with the purposes for which the data have been collected. Intercos s.p.a. has adopted all the minimum security measures provided by the law. Intercos s.p.a., in accordance with the main international standards, has also taken further security measures to minimize risks regarding to the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the personal data collected and processed.

SHARING, COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA

The data we collect may be transferred or communicated to other related to Intercos s.p.a. for activities closely connected and instrumental to the efficiency of the service, such as the management of the data processing system, or for processing made by the other companies for the same purposes.

Apart from said cases, data will not be disclosed nor given to anybody unless this is in compliance with contractual and legal obligations or users have given their consent. Therefore, personal information may be transmitted to third parties solely and exclusively if:

- there is an explicit consent to share data with third parties;
- there is the need to share the information in order to process users' requirements;
- this is essential to execute requests from Judicial Authorities or from the Police.

No data whatsoever coming from the Web is ever disclosed or circulated.

DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

Data subjects have the right, at any time, to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, to know its content and source, to verify its accuracy or to demand its integration, updating or rectification (Art. 7, Legislative Decree 30 June 2003, n. 196). In accordance with said Article, you have the right to ask for the erasure, the anonymization or the blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, and, furthermore, to object on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection.
